

Packshed Manager

Everything that leaves the farm for sale goes through the packshed. The Packshed Manager is responsible for the cleaning, packing and cooling of all produce. The job entails heavy lifting, working with water and keeping the cooler organized and ready for deliveries to customers. The packshed manager is assisted by crew members and works with the crew in the field on non-harvest days if packshed responsibilities are completed. Seasonal position from April to December.

Components of Job:

- Detail orientation
- Ability to lift 50 pound
- Excellent verbal communication skills, ability to read and work with lists
- Ability to multitask, create systems, organize people, prioritize, delegate, cooperate, collaborate and understand and perform even the most humble task on the farm.

Desired Skills:

- Excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Organizational detail orientation (if you're friends call you anal retentive, you are the perfect candidate)
- Ability to remain focused on task at hand, methodically working through the incoming produce
- Ability to direct coworkers who will assist in the packshed
- Previous farm and/or vegetable experience helpful

Compensation: Hourly position, with 40 to 45 hours per week, pay starts at \$9/hour dependent upon experience plus food budget. This position does not offer housing or health benefits.
